Application Period	For applicants to be eligible, they must satisfy both the following requirements:- -Be a Japanese returnee who has lived overseas for more than a year and has returned to Japan in the last year. -Hold at least (or equivalent to) the second grade of the Eiken English proficiency exam. Students who have been enrolled at international schools in Japan, hold foreign citizenship, or otherwise, please consult directly with the admissions department. *Students who are foreign nationals must have legal authorization to study in Japan before applying. *Within the six year levels of junior and senior high, it is possible for students to sit entrance examinations a maximum of three times.*Assisted funding support system available for gifted students.
