<b>Conditions of Eligibility</b>	To be eligible, students must be:- -born between 2nd April, 2006 and 1st April, 2007.																		
	Students must hold at least (or equivalent to) the second grade of the Eiken English proficiency exam.  Students who have been enrolled at international schools in Japan, hold foreign citizenship, or otherwise, please consult directly with the admissions department. *Students who are foreign nationals must have legal authorization to study in Japan before applying. *Within the six year levels of junior and senior high, it is possible for students to sit entrance examinations a maximum of three times. ※Assisted funding support system available for gifted students.

<b>How to Apply</b>	<b>Internet Application</b>  Online applications may be submitted 24 hours a day, during application periods. •The online application form can be accessed and submitted via the Hiroo Gakuen website. •Please be sure to print and bring your exam registration card on the day of the exam.																		
<b>Required Application Documents</b>	•School reports from the last overseas school attended, as well as reports from the school presently being attended (at minimum, those from the most recent year). Submitted reports may be in either Japanese or English. • <b>International Student Education History</b> *Please access Hiroo Gakuen Website and download the document needed to be submitted. *Certificates issued by TOEFL or TOEIC showing Eiken 2nd grade equivalency (or higher). *Please note that it is a rule that submitted documents cannot be returned.
