	To be eligible, students must be:- -for first grade: be born between 2nd April, 2006 and 1st April, 2007; -for second grade: be born between 2nd April, 2005 and 1st April, 2006; -Japanese returnees who have lived overseas for more than a year and have returned to Japan in the last year.																	
	Students must hold at least (or equivalent to) the second grade of the Eiken English proficiency exam. Students who have been enrolled at international schools in Japan, hold foreign citizenship, or otherwise, please consult directly with the admissions department. *Students who are foreign nationals must have legal authorization to study in Japan before applying.
