Submitted reports may be in either Japanese or English. • International Student Education History *Please access Hiroo Gakuen Website and download the document needed to be submitted. *Certificates issued by TOEFL or TOEIC showing Eiken 2nd grade equivalency (or higher). *Please note that it is a rule that submitted documents cannot be returned.

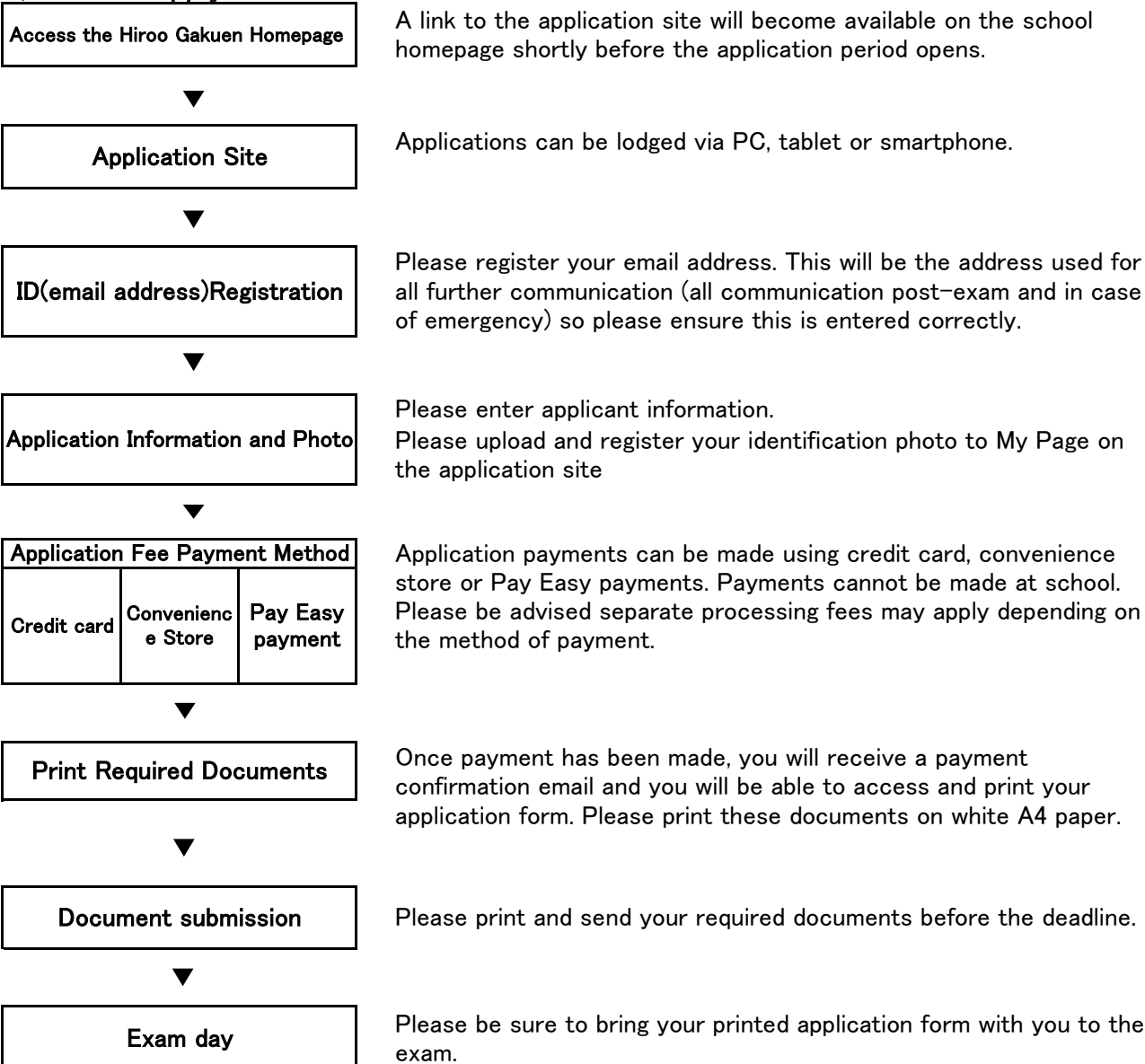
Applications can be lodged 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (including weekends and public holidays)
