Conditions of Eligibility	<p>To be eligible, students must be:- -for first grade: be born between 2nd April, 2006 and 1st April, 2007; -for second grade: be born between 2nd April, 2005 and 1st April, 2006; -Japanese returnees who have lived overseas for more than a year and have returned to Japan in the last year.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Students must hold at least (or equivalent to) the second grade of the Eiken English proficiency exam.</p> <p>Students who have been enrolled at international schools in Japan, hold foreign citizenship, or otherwise, please consult directly with the admissions department. *Students who are foreign nationals must have legal authorization to study in Japan before applying. *Within the six year levels of junior and senior high, it is possible for students to sit entrance examinations a maximum of three times.</p>

The online application form can be accessed and submitted via the Hiroo Gakuen website. •Please be sure to print and bring your exam registration card on the day of the exam.</p>															
Required Application Documents	<p>①International Student Education History *Please access Hiroo Gakuen Website and download the document needed to be submitted. ②Copies of school reports from the last overseas school attended, as well as reports from the school presently attending (at minimum, those from the most recent year). Submitted reports may be in either Japanese or English. ③Copies of certificates issued by TOEFL or TOEIC, showing a score of Eiken 2nd grade equivalency or higher. (if applicable)</p> <p>*Please note that it is a rule that submitted documents cannot be returned.</p>

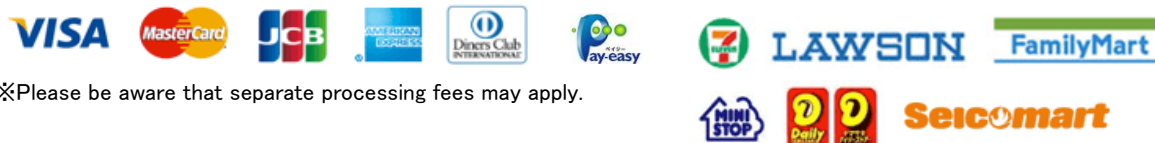

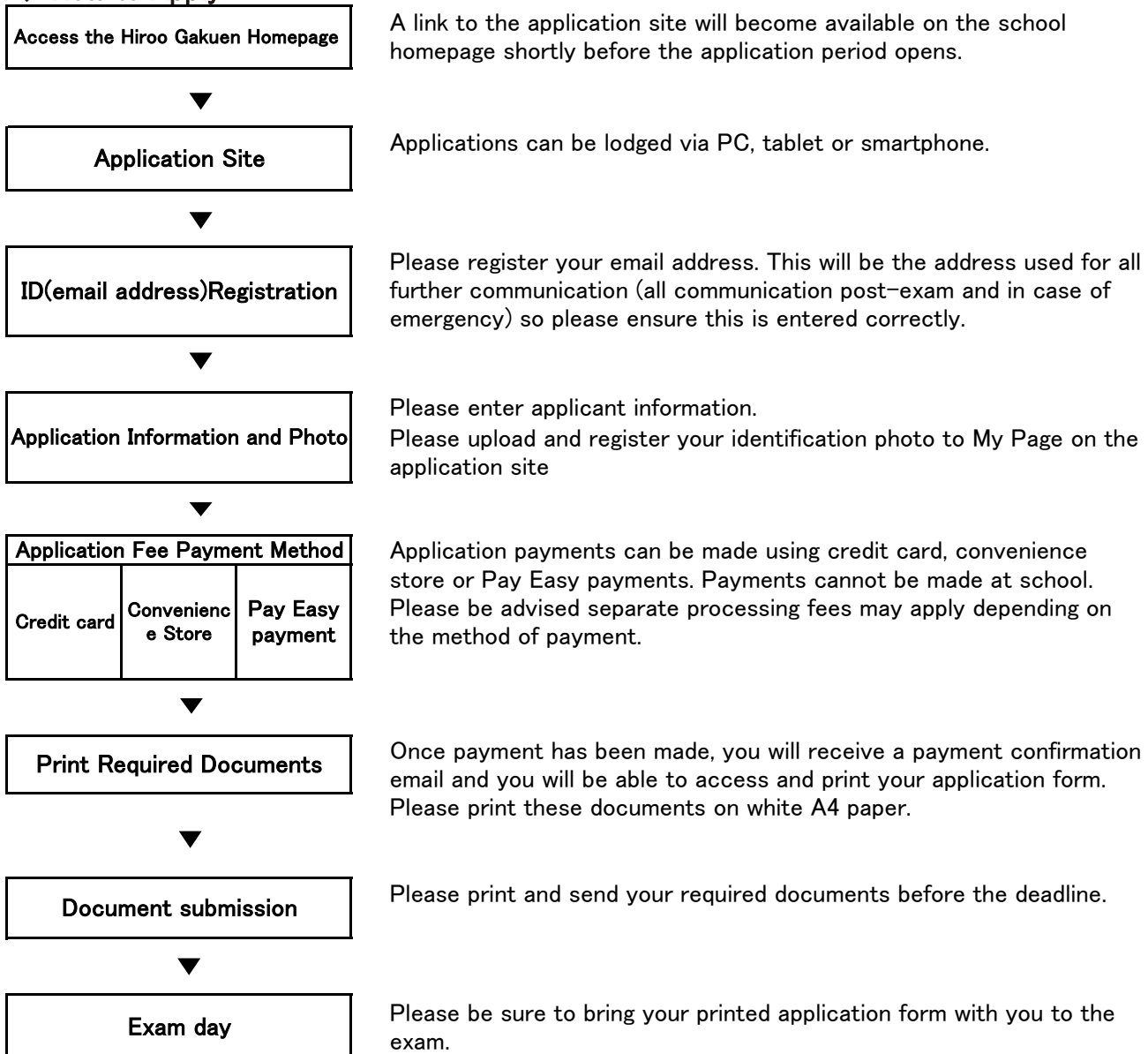
Applications can be lodged 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (including weekends and public holidays)
