How to Apply	<p>Internet Application</p> <p>Online applications may be submitted 24 hours a day during the application period. The online application form can be accessed and submitted via the Hiroo Gakuen website. Note: Please be sure to print and bring your exam registration card on the day of the exam.</p>			
Application Documents	<p>①International Student Education History *Please access Hiroo Gakuen Website and download the document needed to be submitted.</p> <p>②Copies of school reports from the last overseas school attended, as well as reports from the school presently attending (at minimum, those from the last full calendar year). Submitted reports may be in either Japanese or English.</p> <p>③Copies of certificates issued by TOEFL or TOEIC, showing a score of Eiken 2nd grade equivalency or higher. (if applicable) *Please note that submitted documents cannot be returned.</p>			
Document Submission Period	<p>Using a letter pack OR registered mail, the necessary application documents should be mailed to Hiroo Gakuen Admissions office by the deadline. *Please contact us for deadlines and information regarding overseas mail.</p> <p>Thursday, January 25th - Friday, February 9th, 2024 *Application documents must be received by the application deadline.</p>

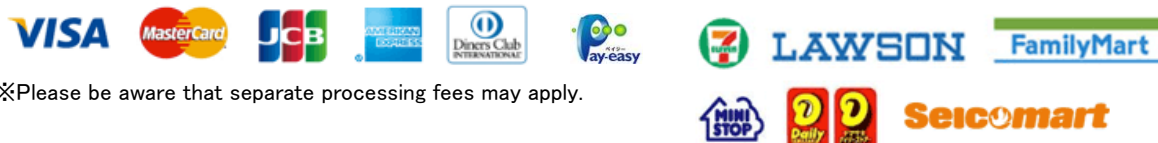

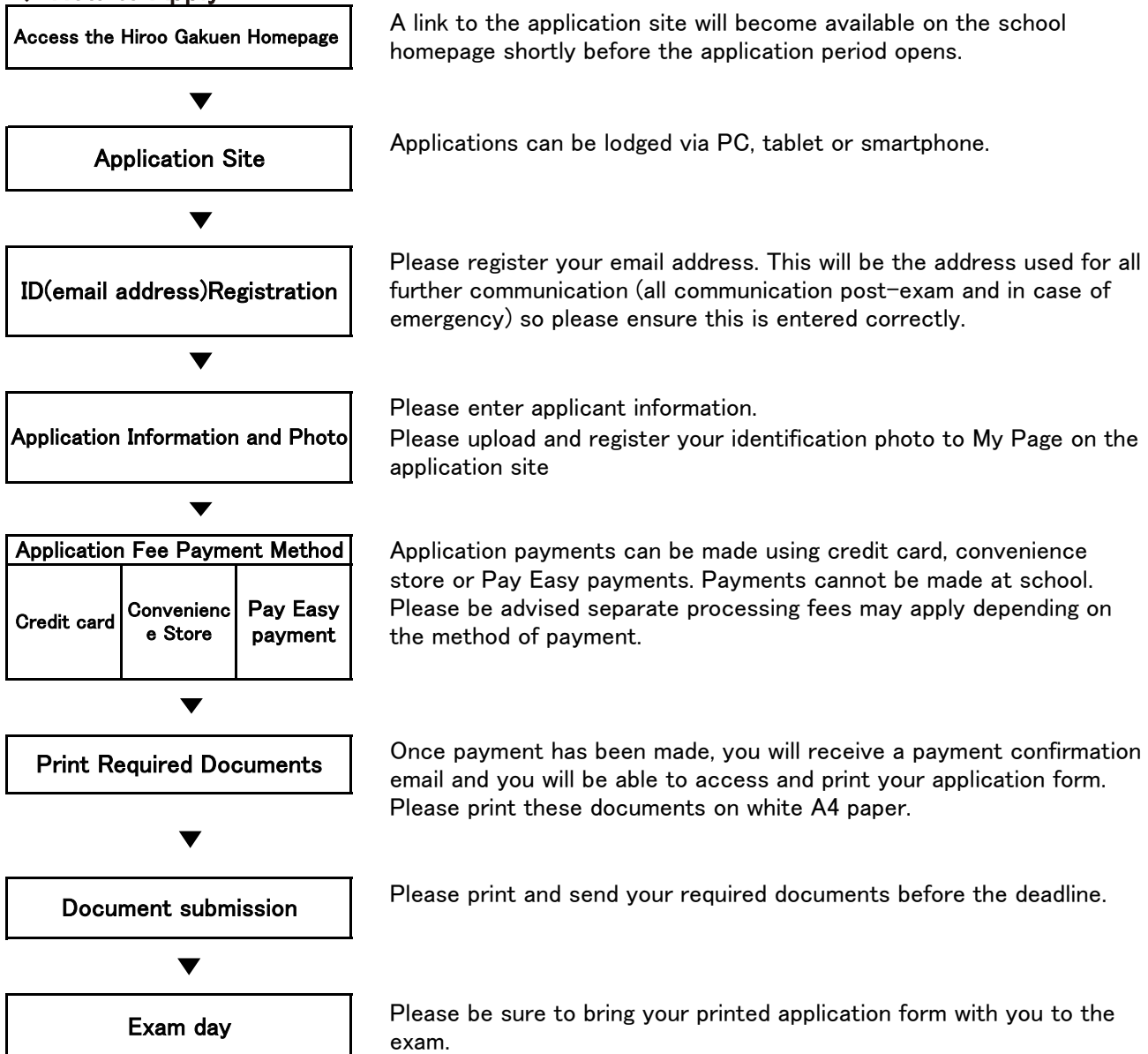
Applications can be lodged 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (including weekends and public holidays)
