Conditions of Eligibility	To be eligible, students must be: - for first grade: be born between 2nd April, 2009 and 1st April, 2010; - for second grade: be born between 2nd April, 2008 and 1st April, 2009; - Japanese returnees who have lived overseas for more than a year and have returned to Japan in the last year. - Students must hold at least (or equivalent to) the second grade of the Eiken English proficiency exam. Students who have been enrolled at international schools in Japan, hold foreign citizenship, or otherwise, please consult directly with the admissions department. ※ Students who are foreign nationals must have legal authorization to study in Japan before applying. ※ Within the six year levels of junior and senior high, it is possible for students to sit entrance examinations a maximum of three times.

How to Apply	Internet Application Online applications may be submitted 24 hours a day, during application periods. The online application form can be accessed and submitted via the Hiroo Gakuen website. Note: Please be sure to print and bring your exam registration card on the day of the exam.			
Application Documents	① Education History : Please access Hiroo Gakuen Website and download the document needed to be submitted. ② Copies of school reports: Copies of school reports from the last overseas school attended, as well as reports from the school presently attending (at minimum, those from the last full calendar year). Submitted reports may be in either Japanese or English. ③ English Qualification (optional): Copies of certificates issued by TOEFL or TOEIC, showing a score of Eiken 2nd ④ Other documents (optional): Copies of previous qualifications, results of standardised examinations, competition results, and any awards. ※ Please note that submitted documents cannot be returned.

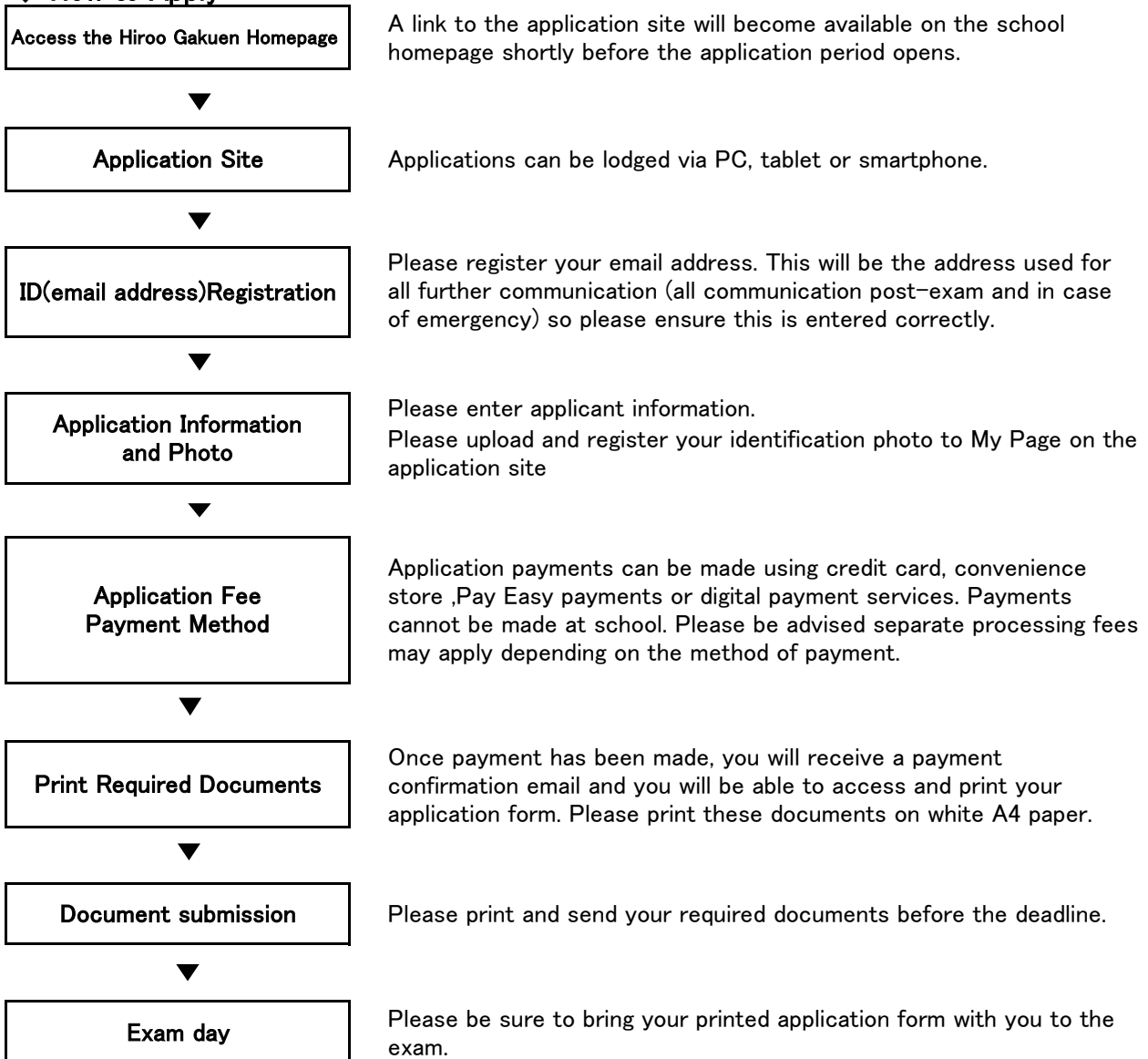
