Application Documents	① Education History: Please access the school website and download the document needed to be submitted. (Please submit this form even if you have not lived abroad before.) ② Copies of School Reports (optional):Submitted reports may be in either Japanese or English. ③ English Qualification (optional): Copies of certificates issued by TOEFL or TOEIC, showing a score of Eiken 2nd grade equivalency or higher. ④ Other documents (optional): Copies of previous qualifications, results of standardised examinations, competition results, and any awards. ※Please note that submitted documents cannot be returned.

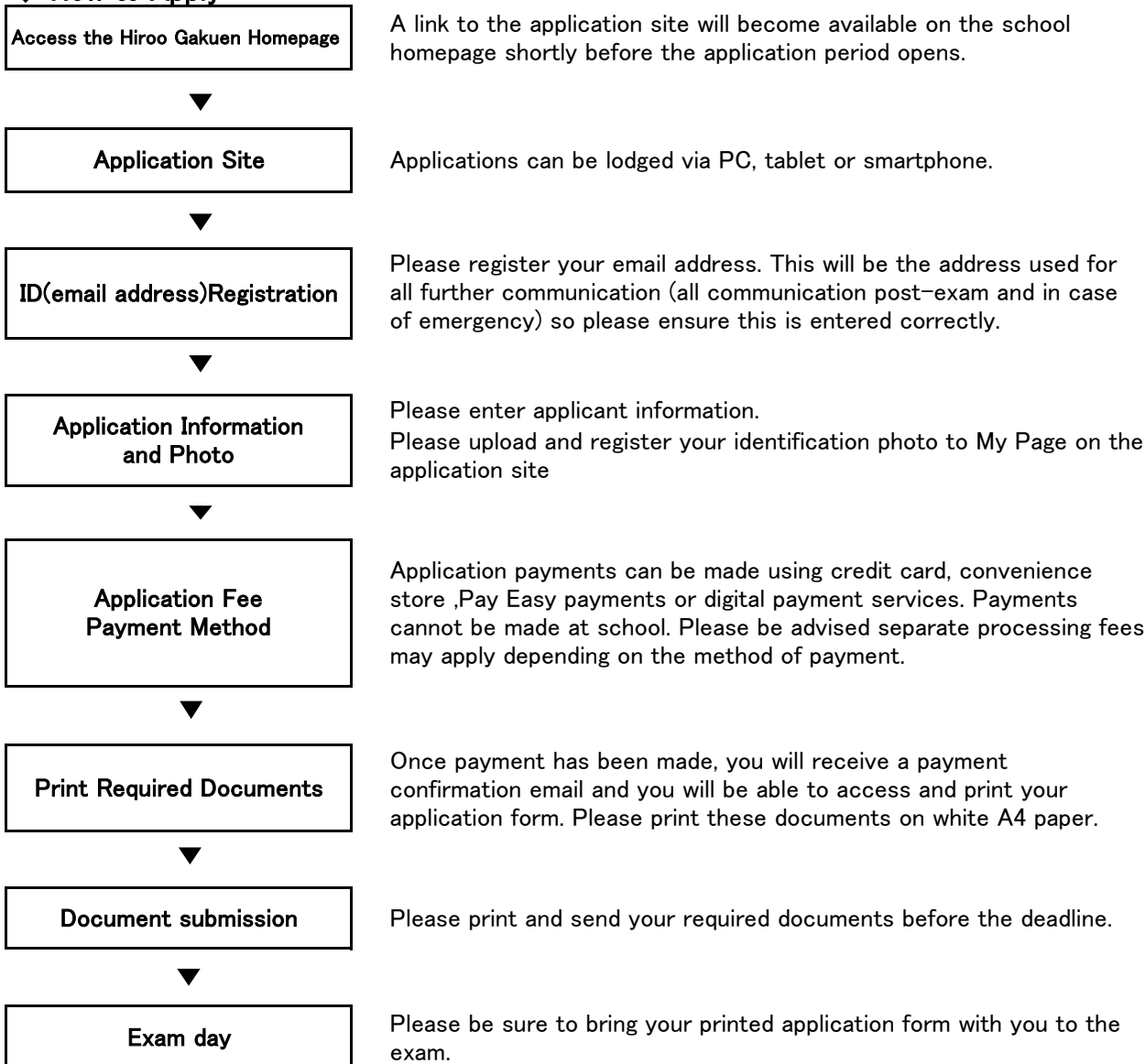
